• Contract Approval by and Between Southern Software a North Carolina Based Corporation and Dandridge Police Department (Software/Management/Support for Records Management System and Mobile Data Information System for the Police Dept)

• Interlocal Agreement Approval Between Jefferson County Emergency Communications and Dandridge Police Department (access to Computer Aided Dispatch records via mobile data computers)

• RFP Approval for Planning Consultant/Administrative Services Contract of the FY2014 Home Project for Housing Rehabilitation Related Services

Only one RFP received:

Community Development Partners, LLC

It came on a motion by Alderman THORNHILL, seconded by Alderman Vice-Mayor NELSON, to approve the RFP from Community Development Partners.

• Approve Grant Contract between State of TN Dept of Environment & Conservation TN Historical Commission & Town of Dandridge - Restoration of Hickman Tavern (masonry repairs & HVAC replacement) - \$12,700 total project (\$7,620 grant / \$5,080 match)

It came on a motion by Alderman KESTERSON, seconded by Alderman FARRAR, to approve the grant contract.

On a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously, and was so ordered.

• Waterfront Dock – Engineering Services

Thompson Engineering - Total cost = \$12,800 (TVA will pay \$5,000, remaining funds to come from occupancy tax revenues).

It came on a motion by Alderman FARRAR, seconded by Alderman THORNHILL, to approve engineering services from Thompson Engineering.

On a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously, and was so ordered.

• Budget Revisions for Utilization of Hall Income Tax Proceeds

Garbage Cans (1/2 load)	\$13,000
Office at FODAC	\$ 6,000

Alderman KESTERSON recommends that income off the sales of garbage cans be earmarked year after year and used for the purchase of new cans.
